One of the tallest *Picea asperata* Mast. (no. 14323) growing on the western slopes of the Gyü-par Range in the Gyü-par Valley, elevation 10200 feet. The base of the trunk is on the lower slopes of the hill. The tree is over 100 feet in height

*Tetraogallus tibetanus Przewalskii* Bianchi, shot on the rocky scree slopes at an elevation of 13200 feet, near the head of Ser-chhen Valley, north-east of Ra-gya.
