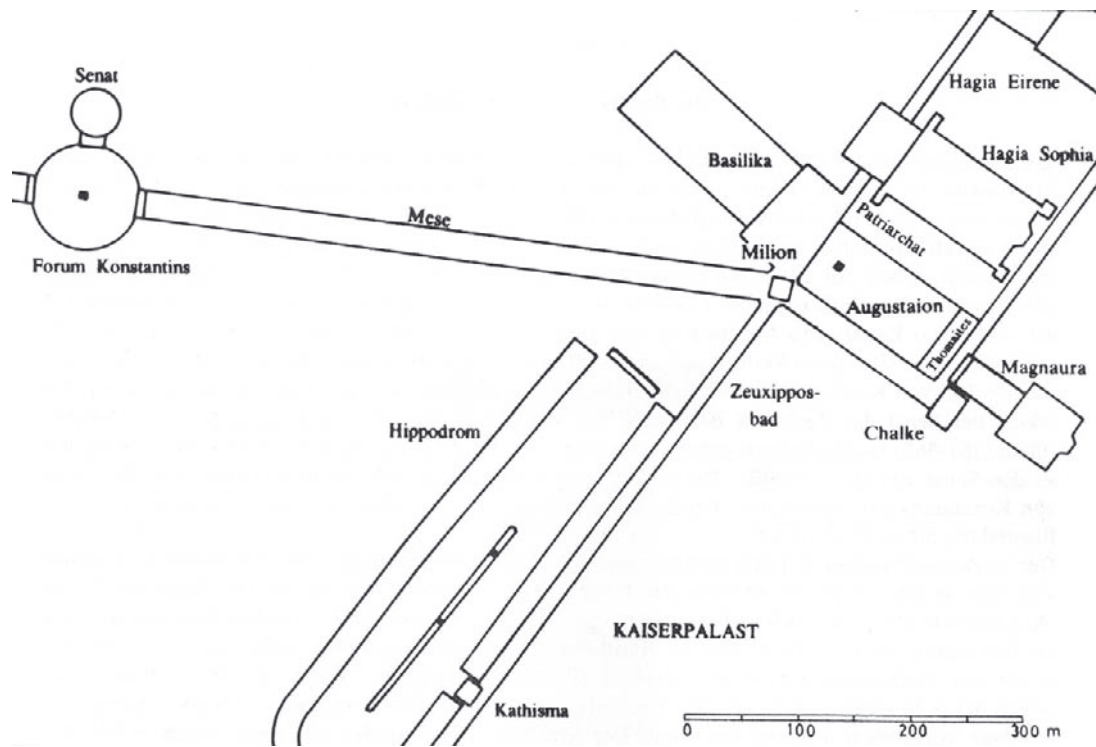


Fig. 6 Hagia Sophia and the nearby monuments

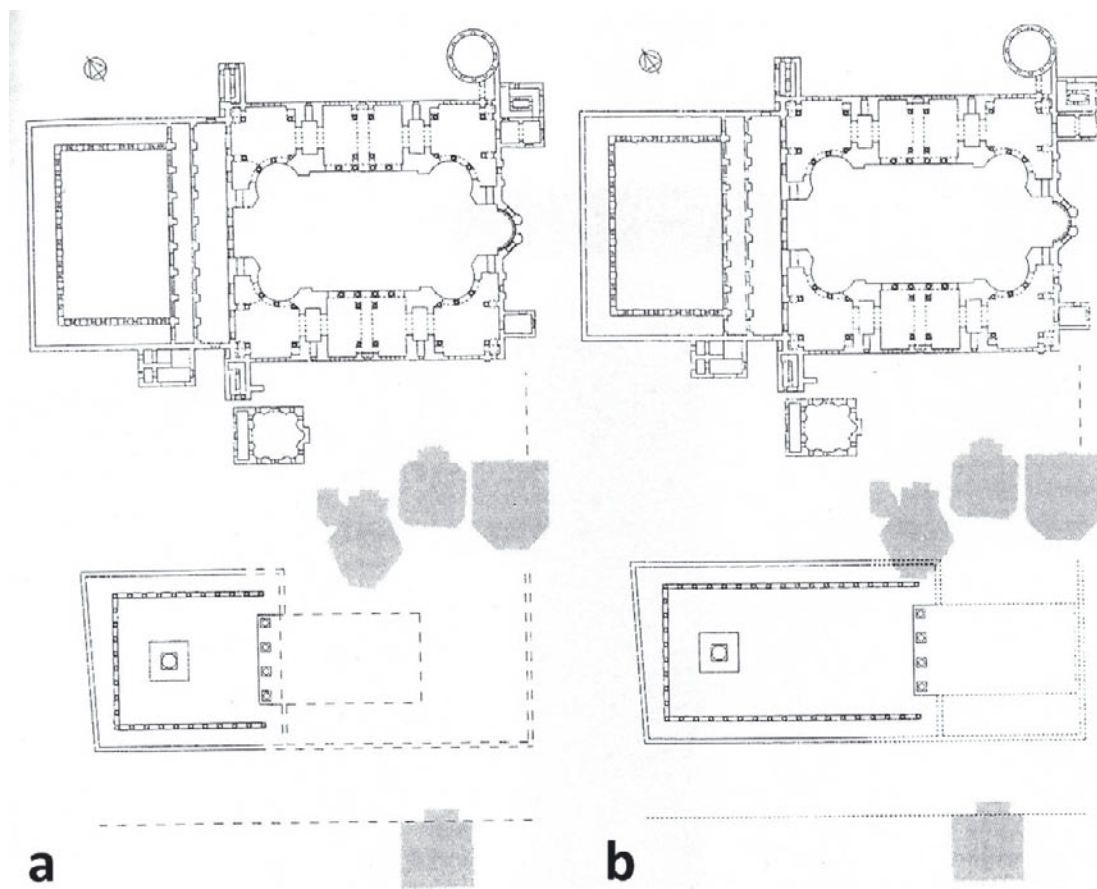


Fig. 7 Augustaion and the Senate House: a) smaller alternative, b) larger alternative

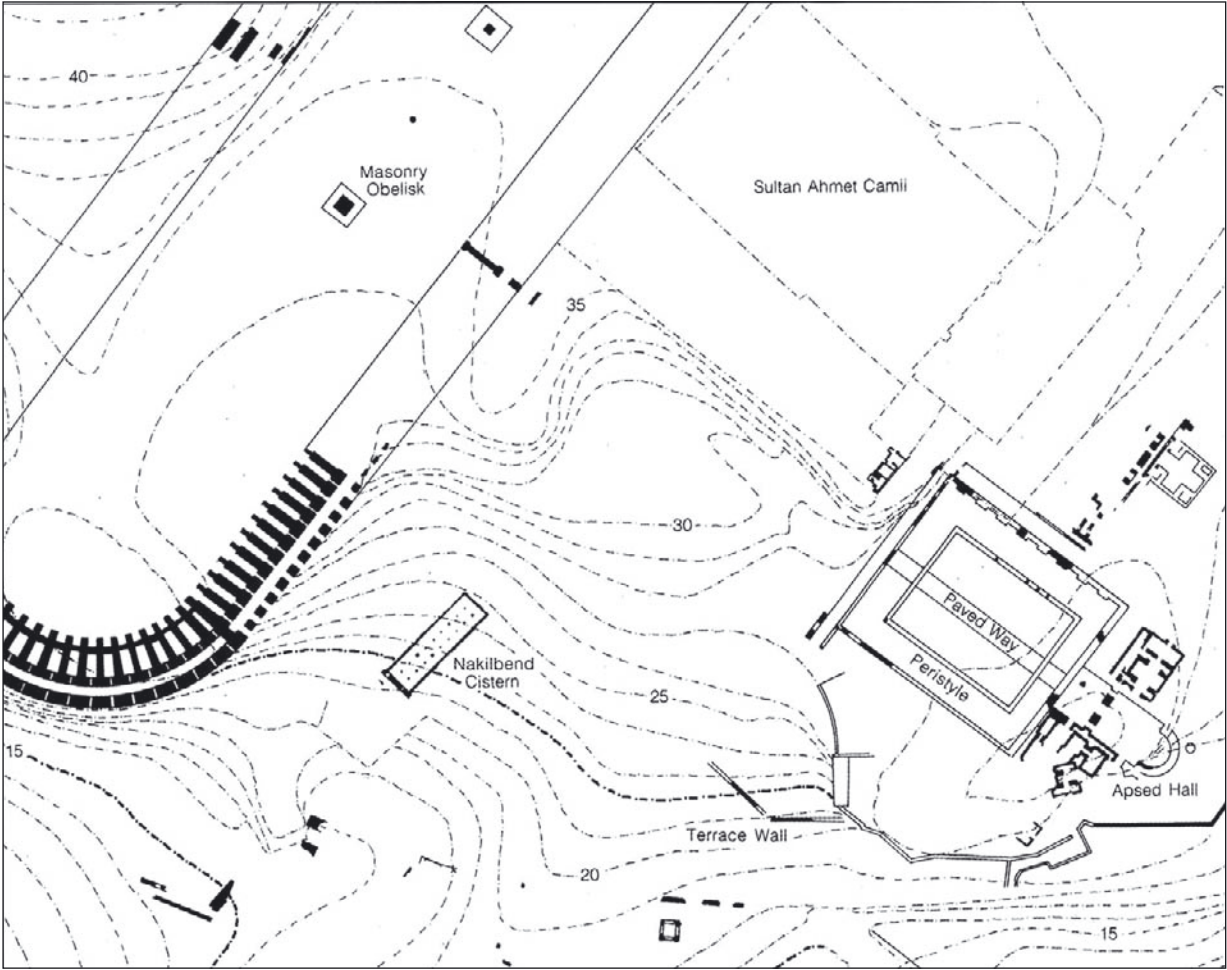


Abb. 3: Der Boukoleonpalast und die beiden untersten Palastterrassen auf 11 bzw. 16 m ü.d.M.

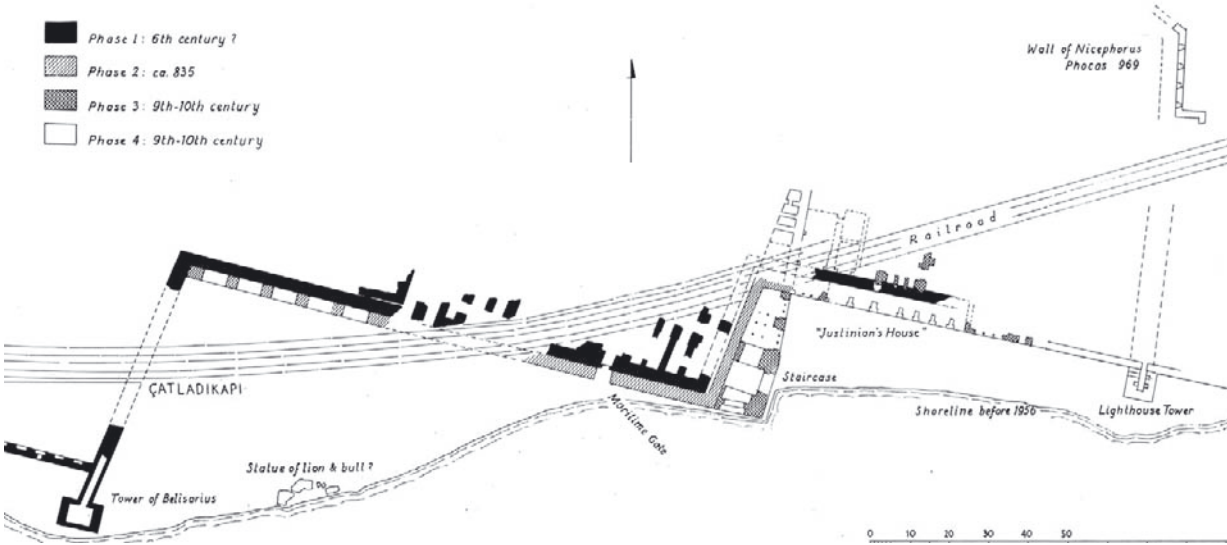


Abb. 4: Grober Überblicksplan über die Seemauer am Boukoleonhafen

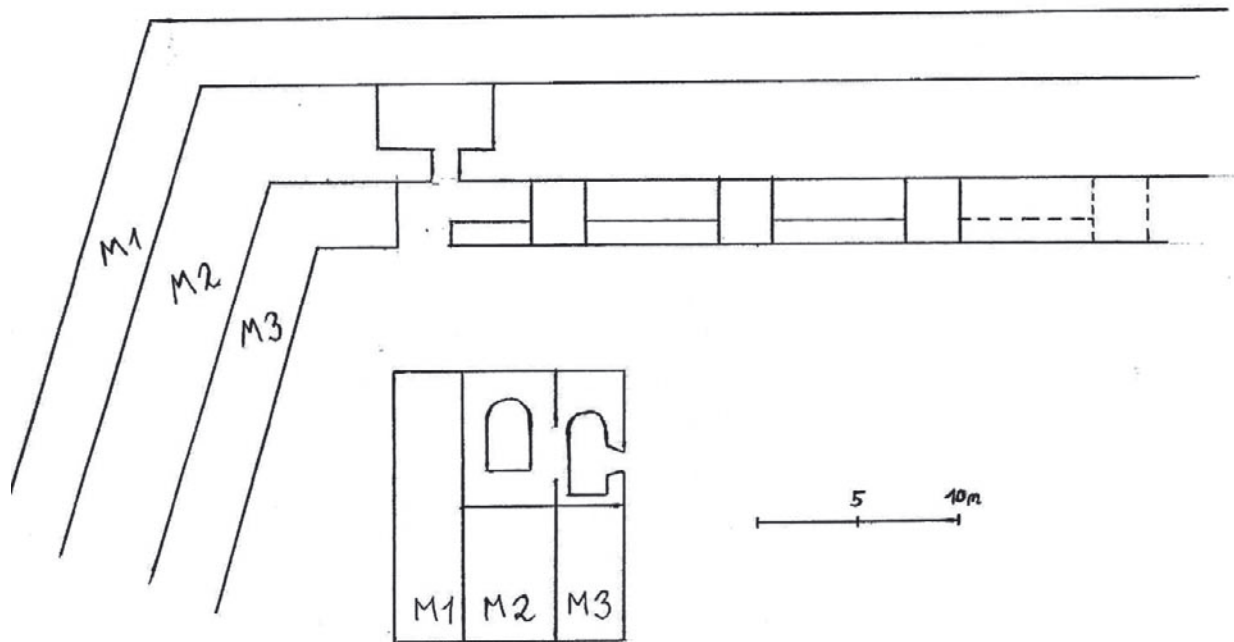


Abb. 5: Bauphasen der Seemauer. Grundriss der Ecke nördlich des Belisar-Turms mit den später zugemauerten Arkaden.
Darunter: Querschnitt mit den Wehrgängen von M 2 und M 3

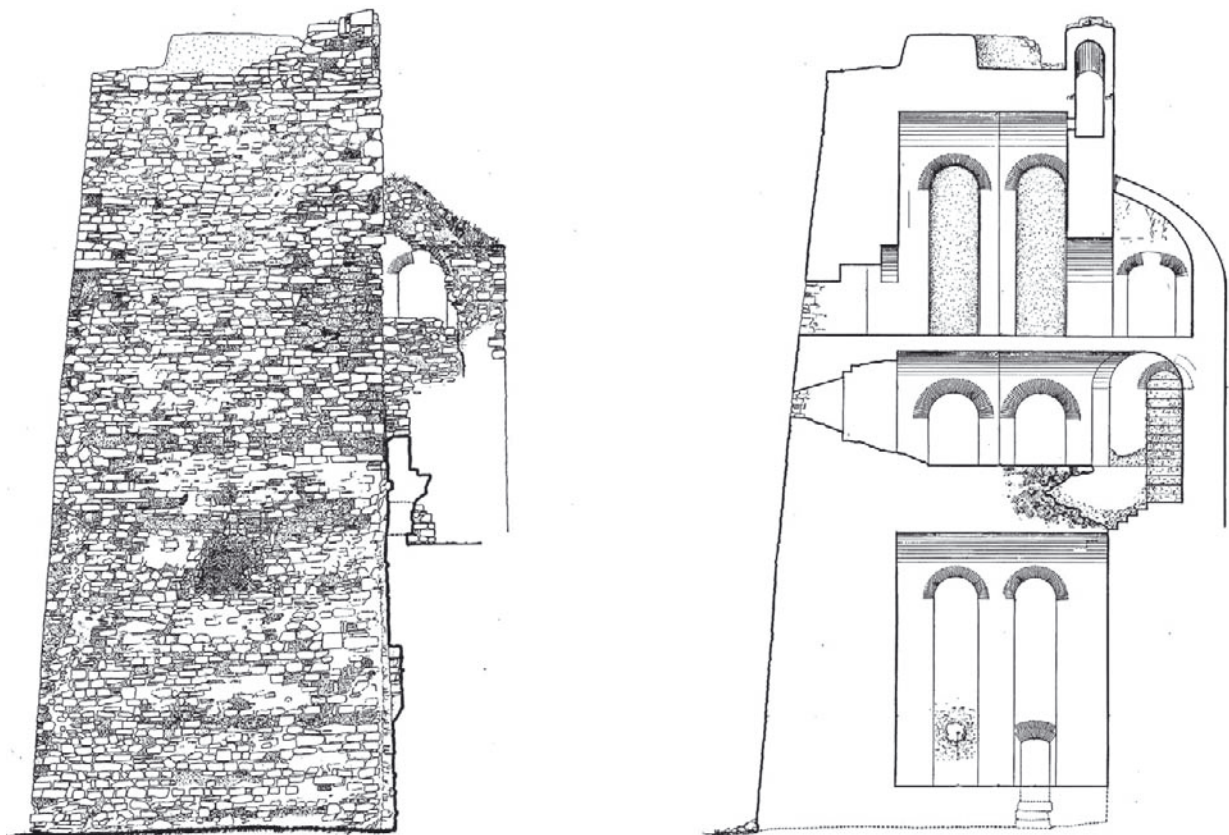


Abb. 6: Der sogenannte Leuchtturm am Ende des östlichen Winkels

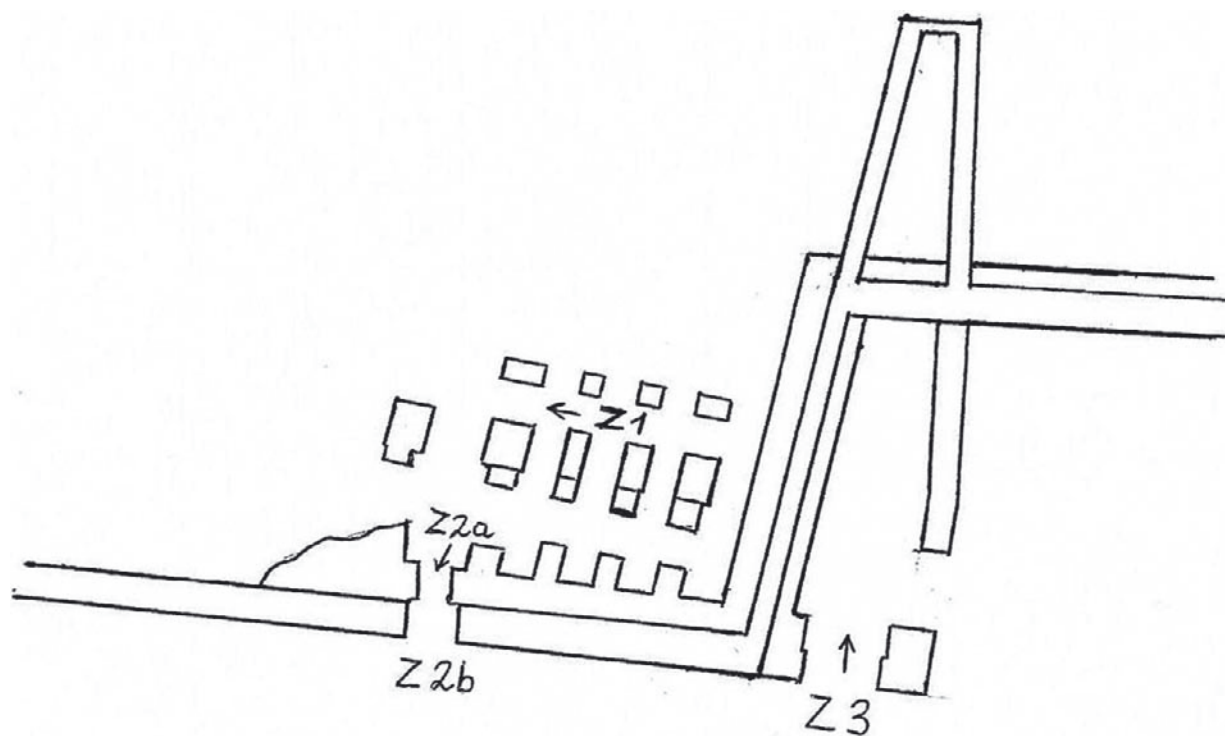


Abb. 7: Die hafenseitigen Zugänge zum Palast

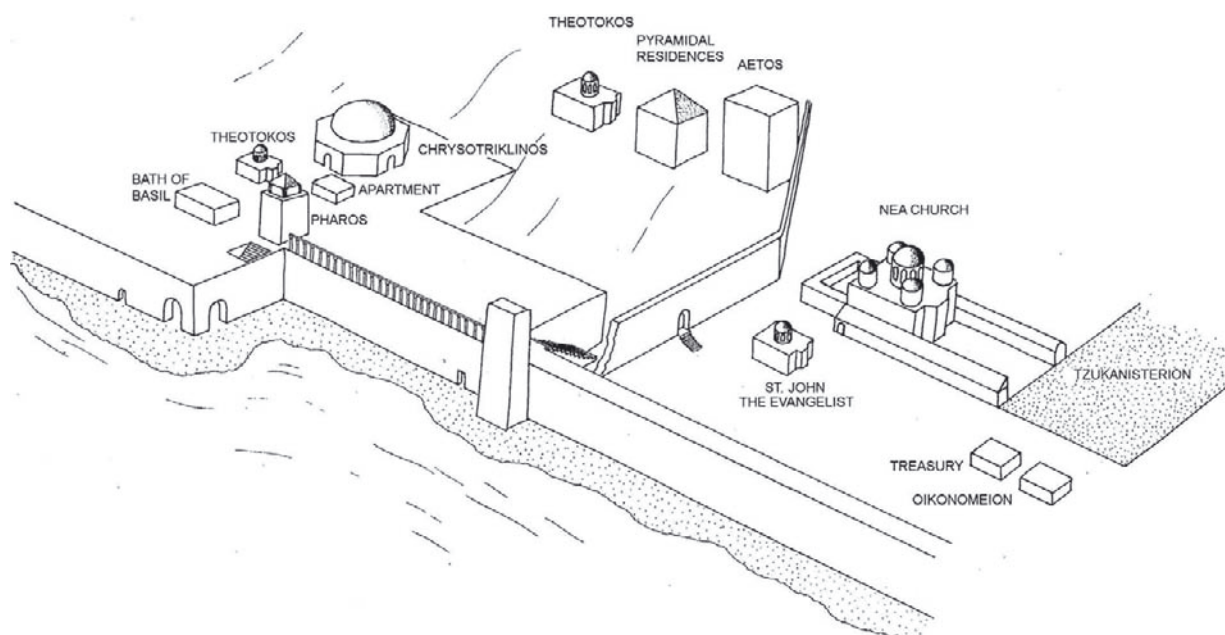


Abb. 8: Rekonstruktion der Pharos-Terrasse durch J. Bardill.

Der Mosaikschmuck ist hypothetisch, ebenso der Aufbau des Leuchtturmes und die Mole im Hintergrund

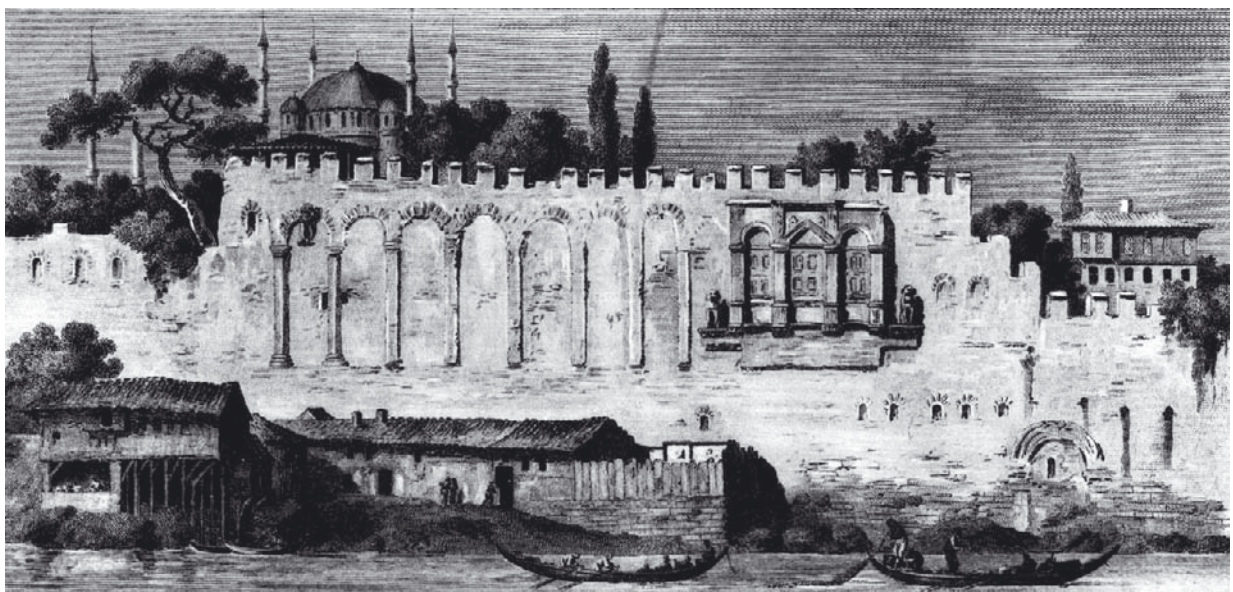


Abb. 10: Der westliche Winkel mit dem Spolienensemble. Rechts unten das kleine Seeportal Z 2.

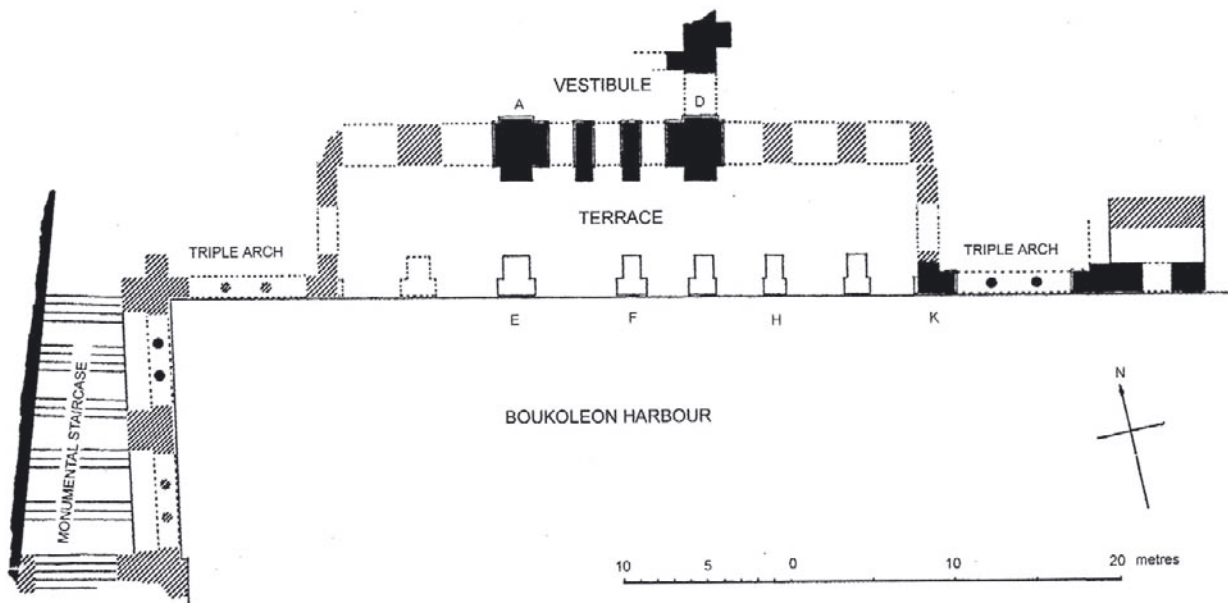


Abb. 12: Grundriss des Seepavillons („Haus des Justinian“).

Abb. 13: Blick durch die Loggia des östlichen Winkels („Haus des Justinian“) auf das Marmarameer

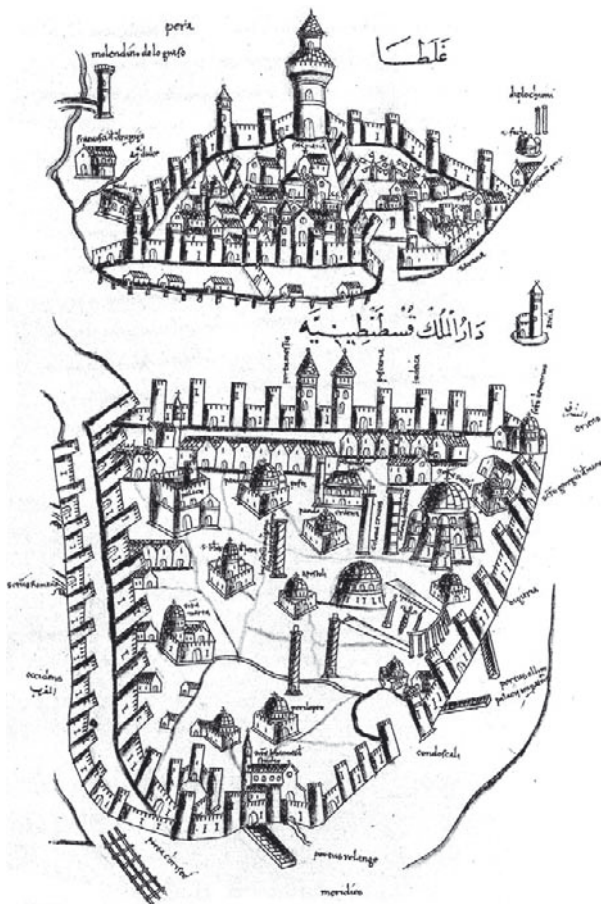


Abb. 14: Ansicht von Konstantinopel nach C. Buondelmonti.

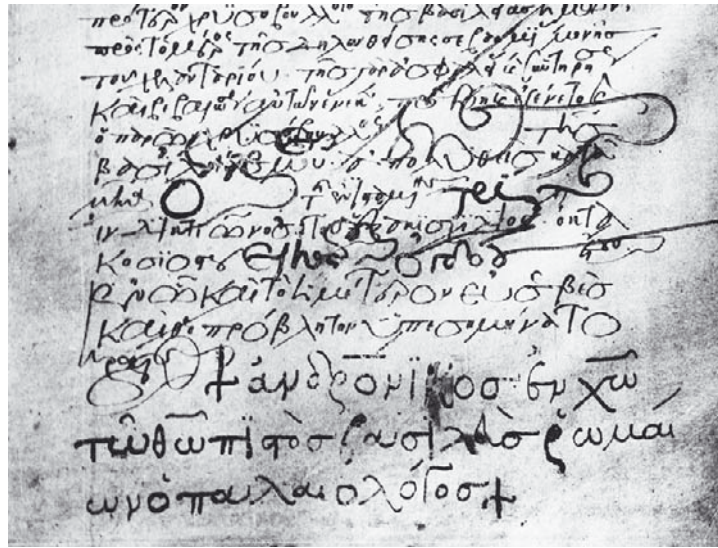


Abb. 1a: DR 2416: Andronikos II. für Chilandar (März 1319)

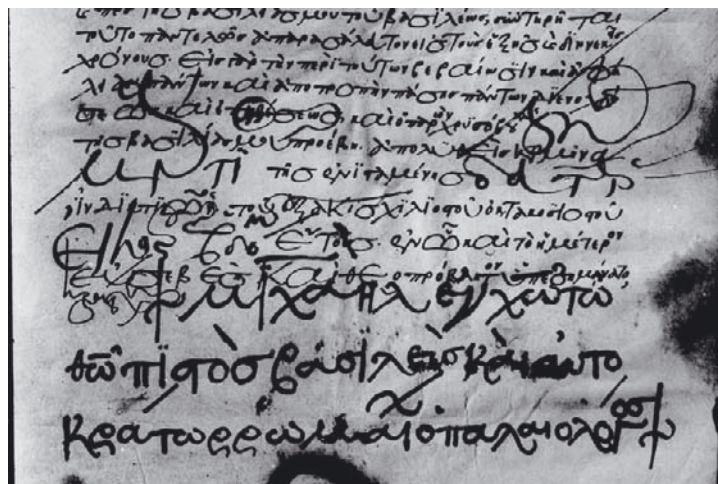


Abb. 1b: DR 2634: Michael IX. für Chilandar (März 1319)

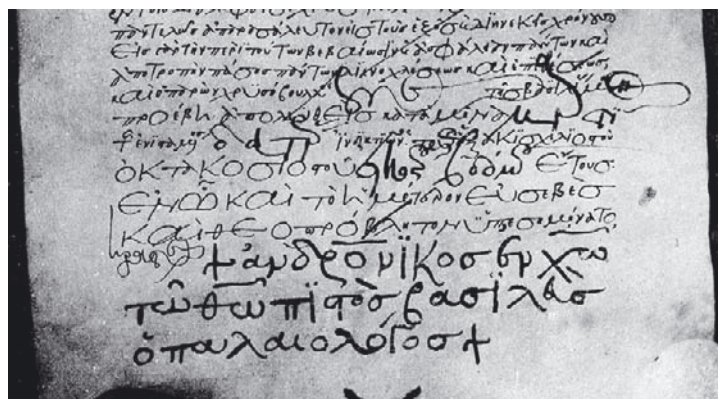


Abb. 1c: DR 2650: Andronikos III. für Chilandar (März 1319)

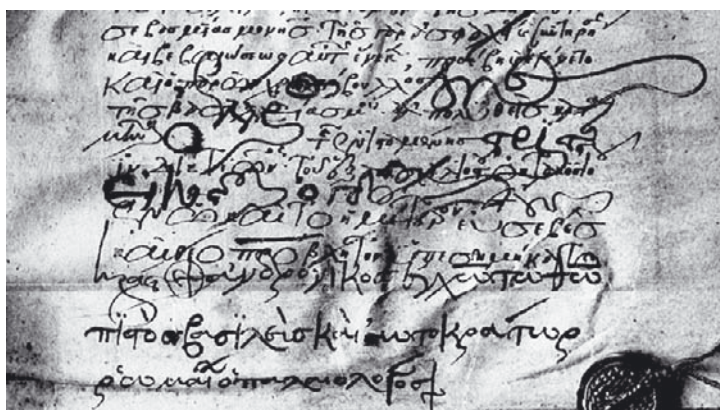


Abb. 2a: DR 2432: Andronikos II. für Chilandar (Oktober 1319)

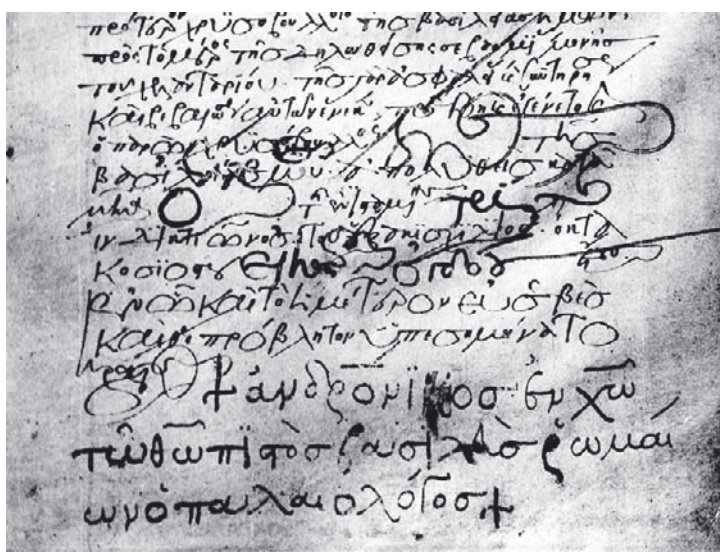


Abb. 2b: DR 2651: Andronikos III. für Chilandar (Oktober 1319)

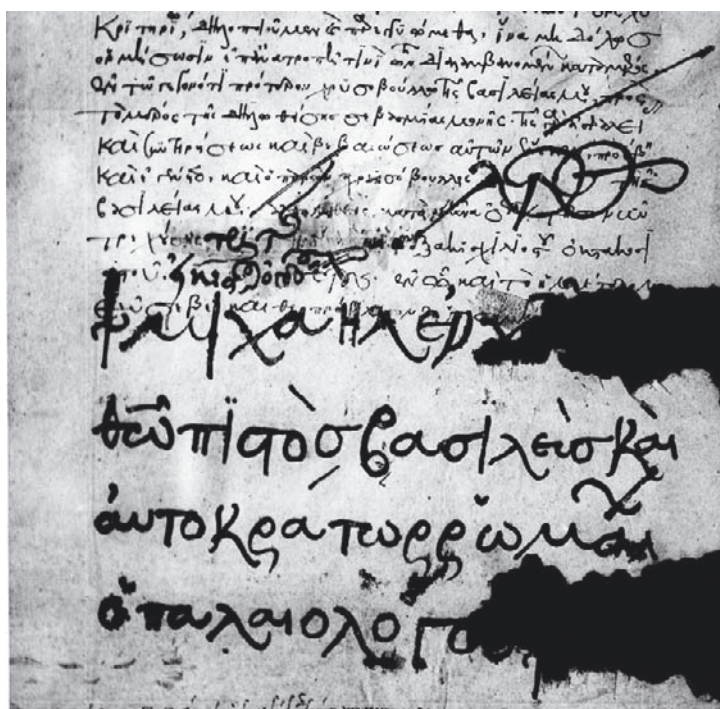


Abb. 2c: DR 2639: Michael IX. für Chilandar (Oktober 1319)

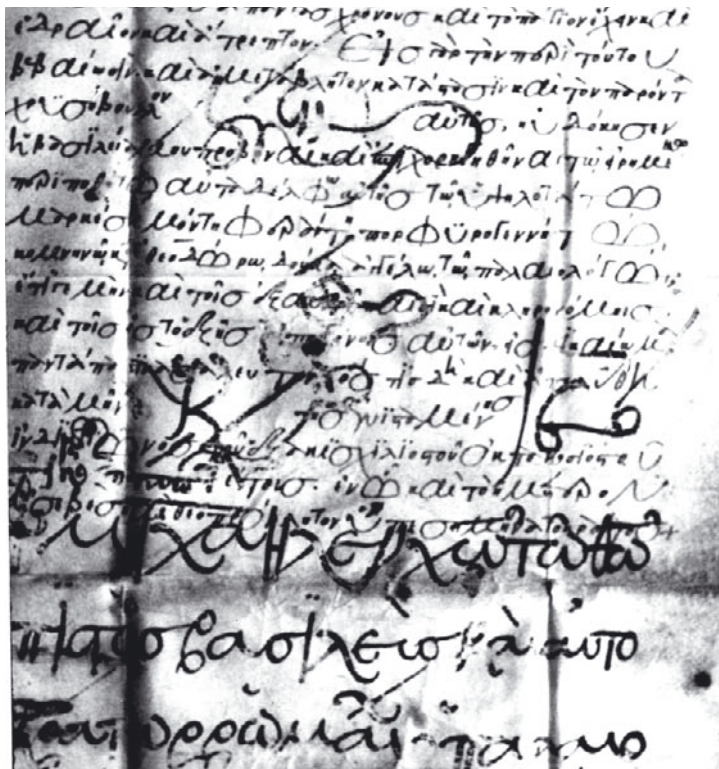


Abb. 3a: DR 2630: Michael IX. für Theodoros Palaiologos von Montferrat (Dezember 1316)

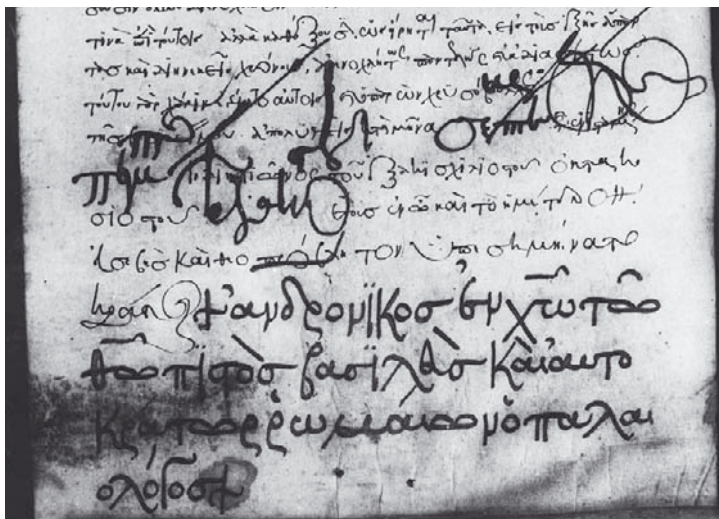


Abb. 3b: DR 2664: Andronikos III. für Chilandar (September 1321)

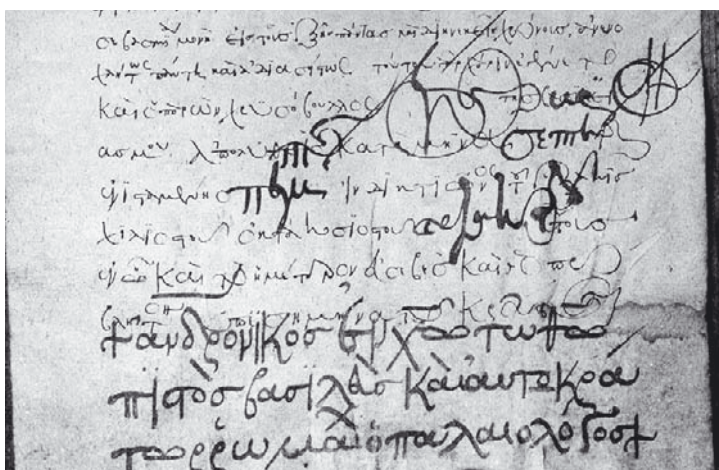


Abb. 3c: DR 2665: Andronikos III. für Chilandar (September 1321)
