

## Water in climate change – A background report of CIPRA, no. 03/2011

Alpine rivers supply more than 170 millions of people with water. Climate change is going to reduce this water availability in the Alps and also in other regions. Water demand will rise as will the competition between different stakeholder groups. In the 31-page compact dossier CIPRA presents reports showing the effects from climate change to water utility, as well as political instruments and good practice examples. ## A multivision *For the Alps*: an original and unique audiovisual event

*For the Alps* is an audiovisual production created by ALPARC and built around more than 400 photographs painstakingly selected from the 10000 shots taken and shortlisted by park officers in nearly 60 protected areas. These areas are represented by 20 management bodies who are full partners in this unique creative piece.

*For the Alps* pays visual tribute to the diversity found in the Alps: landscapes, cultures, habitats, lifestyles, and the potential for creating links between these areas that are slowly being fragmented.

Like a sensible and aesthetic testimony, *For the Alps* is the basis of the dialogue between local actors, protected area administrators and visitors. The multivision takes the viewer on an unusual journey through the Alps, travelling from the lofty mountain heights to inhabited areas, from East to West, North to South. It is like being picked up and carried along at the will of the four winds.
